

Multi-Colour Collage Paper

Look at all those colours! In this simple, yet fun activity we will be creating multi-colour collage paper, so you can create a colorful masterpiece. This project is a great way to use up scrap paper and explore your creativity using fun colour combinations.

Materials:

- Construction Paper
- Black Sharpie/Black Marker
- Glue Stick
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Take a sheet of black construction paper and set it aside. This will be used as the background.
2. Pick a few different coloured sheets of construction paper. Think about how your colour combinations can help create an interesting picture.
3. Now that you have your colours, tear up the construction paper into random blobs of different sizes. (See Fig. 1)

4. Begin gluing your pieces down on the black piece of construction paper. Allow them to hang off the edge and overlap different pieces. (See Fig. 2)
5. Once your entire sheet is covered, flip it over and trim off the extra pieces. (See Fig. 3)
6. Now that your sheet is trimmed, turn it back over and use a black sharpie/marker to draw your shape outline (Example. Hand, heart, star, raindrops, animal, shapes, plants/flowers, etc.)

Extras and Tips

- Colour Combinations: Primary, secondary, warm, cool, rainbow, monochromatic, complementary, etc.
- If you have lots of colours, try to glue them so that the same colours are not touching.
- Make sure your pieces are fully glued down to keep your sheet tidy.
